

# Information on Intensive Japanese Language Course (Spring Term)

[Target] Those who plan to enter high school in the spring of 2026

[Capacity] 10~15 people per class

[Study period]

April 21, 2025 - January 16, 2026 24 weeks (approximately 600 hours)

April to July (12 weeks), October to January (12 weeks)

[Goal] Japanese Language Proficiency Test N3 equivalent

[Contents] In addition to acquiring the Japanese language skills necessary to deal with everyday situations, students will be able to understand information and express their opinions on social themes that interest them. They will also acquire basic reading and writing skills to tackle academic studies. You will also learn about Japanese culture, customs, manners and school life.

[Class hours] 5 hours per day, 5 days per week

\*In addition to the above fees, you will need to pay actual costs for textbooks and other teaching materials.


\*You will need to prepare your own tablet device (laptop) to submit assignments.
